Shark Matching Game

Matching games are a great way for your child to start preparing for school while having fun. There are six different kinds of sharks on the cards. Starting at the top left, they are the sawfish, whale shark, great white shark, hammerhead shark, river ray, and Helicoprion or buzzsaw shark (a prehistoric shark).

You'll need:

- Two sets of the shark game pieces printed out
- Scissors
- Optional clear packing tape or lamination

What to do:

1. Cut out the shark pieces along the dashed lines— this is a good chance for children to practice using scissors.
2. Optional: Laminate the game pieces to help them last longer. You can also print them on cardstock to make them more durable.
3. Use the pieces to play matching and memory games. Can you find the matches? If your child is very young, simply lay them all face up and let your child find the ones that match.
