

## **Paper Roll Binoculars**

Exploring the world around us with binoculars can be a good way to find new things. Even though these binoculars won't help you see farther, they will help focus on a specific area.

## You'll need:

- 2 paper rolls
- Yarn or string
- Scissors or hole punch
- Glue or tape
- Paper
- Coloring supplies

## What to do:

- 1. Decorate the paper with the coloring supplies.
- 2. Tape or glue the two rolls together.
- 3. Wrap the decorated paper around the rolls and tape or glue in place.
- 4. Use scissors or a hole punch to cut a small hole on the outside of each roll about a half inch from the top.
- 5. Take one end of your yarn and thread it through the hole. Tie a knot to secure it. Do the same thing with the other end of the yarn.
- 6. Now you're ready to start exploring! What can you see?
