## Butterfly Wings

Butterflies start out as caterpillars and go through a complete metamorphosis to emerge as an adult with wings! With this craft, little ones can create their own wings for their butterfly.

### You'll need:

- Coffee filter
- Clothespin
- Pipe cleaner
- Washable markers
- Spray bottle with water or paint brush and water

### What to do:

1. Flatten out the coffee filter on a tray or newspaper.
2. Color the filter with washable markers – get creative!
3. Use the spray bottle or a paint brush and water to blend the colors. Let dry.
4. Twist the pipe clear into antenna and loop around the clothespin.
5. Once the filter is dry scrunch it in between the clothespin to create the butterfly wings.
