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Mini Wolf Luminary

In winter the days are shorter, and the nights are longer. In some places wolves can be heard howling at night. While some people think they're howling at the moon, they are in fact talking with each other. With this craft you can create a candle luminary to light up the dark winter nights with a howling wolf.

You'll need:

- Small glass jar, like a baby food jar
- Tissue paper
- Scissors
- Elmer's glue
- Water
- Paintbrush
- Wire
- Tealight candle



What to do:

1. Rip or cut the tissue paper up into small pieces.
2. Cut out the silhouette of the howling wolf at the bottom of this page.
3. Glue tissue pieces to the glass jar.
4. Glue the wolf silhouette onto the tissue paper.
5. In a small bowl, mix equal amounts of Elmer's glue and water together.
6. Use a paintbrush to coat the outside of the glass jar with glue/water mixture.
7. Let dry for about 20 minutes.
8. Wrap a piece of wire around the rim of the jar. Use a second piece to create a handle.
9. Place small candle in bottom of jar and enjoy!
