Fossil Skeleton Craft

Fossils are the remains of an animal or plant that has turned to stone over many years. With this craft, you will be able to make your own petrified fossil: the remains of a living thing where minerals have replaced the original material.

You'll need:

- Construction paper
- Q-tips
- Glue
- Crayon or pencil
- Scissors

What to do:

1. Use the crayon or pencil to draw an outline of an animal, like a t-rex or mammoth.
2. Cut some of the Q-tips into different lengths.
3. Lay out the Q-tips where the bones like the vertebra, ribs and legs would go.
4. Once everything is laid out, glue them down in place and let dry.
